The purpose of the Albert and Gernell Smart Foundation Scholarship Fund is to provide scholarships to outstanding high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a course of study at either a two-year or four-year educational institution.

The Albert and Gernell Smart Foundation will award a minimum of one scholarship, ranging in the amount of \$500 to \$1,000. (Additional scholarships may be awarded based on applications and available scholarship funds.) **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration or formal acceptance letter from an accredited higher educational institution.** 

#### Criteria and eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 2. The applicant must be a resident of Bexar County.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate and explain community involvement.

#### **General Instructions**

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is May 9th, 2020 11:59 p.m. (No exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application for a list of required supporting documentation. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. Please put "N/A" in the space if any question does not apply.
- 4. The application and requested documents must be mailed in one (1) packet to the address on page 2. The scholarship application deadline is May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The scholarship application must be postmarked no later than May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- 5. You will be notified by email on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 and by mail by May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 regarding the status of your application.

#### **Application Process:**

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application.
- 2. An official high school transcript in a sealed envelope must be submitted with the application packet.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation must accompany application packet. One of the letters must be from a teacher or counselor. All letters must have hand written signatures across the seal. Each letter MUST be in a *separate* sealed envelope.
- 4. A typed essay on the assigned subject of 400 to 600 words.
- 5. (Optional) Please submit no more than "2" photos for inclusion into a banquet presentation and OES media.
