- 5. Describe the role of character and integrity in the choices you make. Please offer specific examples.
- 6. What are your career goals? Where do you see yourself in ten years?
- 7. Please consider any additional information- What has been your most rewarding experience? Are there extenuating circumstances in your life? (illness, death in the family, divorce, move, family problems, etc.)
